Within a few days of the July 25th meeting, the autopatch code will be changed and the new one effective.

The club desperately needs someone who operates with MS Office on their computer, to assume the role as Membership Committee Chairmanship and to maintain the SARO data base, used to print the roster, mailing labels and dues records. We also need someone to assume the role of Newsletter/Bulletin Editor. Again, the same MS Office program will ensure compatibility with existing templates and records.

SARO has supported several functions, the Battle of Bands and the Water Safari, to name a couple so far this year. Stay in touch with Alfred Horn KG5QW, Clay Laster W5ZPV and Gil Mathis AA5XH, for a schedule of events.

We need to also thank Lee Besing N5NTG, for offering to host a SARO Web Site on the Internet. Hopefully by the July 25th meeting, we will have more info and something will be on line for everyone to access.

Again, I hope someone will consider becoming the Membership Chairman and also someone to handle the Bulletin. These are needed functions, and the few members who have been doing it all, just cannot continue the time that is needed to do everything for the club.

You will come to Trinity Baptist Church (it's the big building on the right with a steeple, about 3 blocks from IH-37). At the end of the Church take the first left which is Carleton (please note the street sign is in the trees) and go 2 blocks South to E. Magnolia. The Ruble Center will be on the left.
